

IN SUPPORT OF A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM TO PROTECT OUR WATER

Dunes City is strongly dependent on the lake environment and water quality. We consider that future and on going large-scale developments which are not adequately designed and controlled would present a great risk to Woahink Lake and Siltcoos Lake due to the greatly increased number of septic systems draining into the lake and the excessive run off due to construction on steep slopes, sediment load, nutritional load input and injury to the riparian zones.

The **UNDERSIGNED RESIDENTS OF DUNES CITY** hereby support enactment of a temporary and limited moratorium on the building of major and minor subdivisions and PUDs in order to establish and implement ordinances providing increased water quality and water quality monitoring and protection. We further request the City Council to immediately and formally adopt the specific limited Temporary Moratorium measures which the Council caused to be duly transmitted, in preliminary form, to the Department of Land Conservation and Development in its December, 2005, meeting. This should permit corrective measures to be initiated and put in place and funding sources to be approached for support..
